



Central Coast Volleyball Club Social Competition Covid-19 Policy

(Effective as at Friday 14 January 2022)

Central Coast Volleyball Club (CCVC) is looking forward to offering club members a social competition in 2022. As everyone would be aware, the situation has evolved in 2022 where Covid-19 is spreading at a more rapid rate than in previous years, increasing the likelihood of an individual contracting the virus. As a result, CCVC cannot guarantee that whilst participating in the Social Competition that you will not come into contact with a person who has tested Positive for Covid-19.

Individuals should take this fact and all information provided by health authorities into account before making a decision to register for the social competition, as once an individual has committed to a team they will need to fulfil their obligations for the entire season.

CCVC will be putting into place procedures to minimise the risk of Covid-19 transmission, including:

- Following all NSW Health Advice in relation to Community Sport
- Following all Health & Safety Protocols required by Breakers Stadium
- Using discretion to grant exceptions to the Social Competition Rules on a case-by-case basis to some or all of the following areas:
 - Draw and Scheduling
 - Replacement Player Rules
 - Duty Rules
 - Forfeit Policy

CCVC cannot legally force individuals participating in the Social Competition to advise the club of a positive diagnosis, however by failing to do so may cause the unnecessary further spread of Covid-19 throughout the club and the community. To ensure privacy is maintained, individuals should only advise CCVC of a positive diagnosis via email to comp.cvc@gmail.com and provide the following information:

- Date Tested Positive
- Volleyball Events attended
- Date Isolation Ends (if known)

CCVC will not disclose the identity of the individual/s who have tested positive when advising members of occasions where a positive case has attended a Social Competition evening.

As everyone has experienced in 2020 and 2021, circumstances can change very quickly which can see events postponed and/or cancelled. Where the Social Competition is impacted, we will communicate the changes to our members via email. Where portions of a season are cancelled, CCVC may rebate participants a portion of their entry fee proportionate to the amount of matches unplayed by their team.
